

Birthday of the Church II Cross References

Romans 4:5: “To him that worketh not, but believeth on Him...his faith is counted for righteousness”

James 2:24: “...Ye see then how that *by works* a man is justified, *and not by faith only*”

Ephesians 2:8-10: “For by grace are ye saved through faith...*not of works*...we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus *unto* good works”

Titus 3:5-8,14: “Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us...they which have believed in God might be careful to *maintain* good works...that they be not unfruitful”

Colossians 1:26: “Even the mystery *which hath been hid from ages and from generations*, but now is made manifest...”

Acts 15:15: “...to this *agree* the words of the prophets...”

Romans 12:5: “So we, being many, *are one body in Christ*...”

I Corinthians 10:17: “For we being many are...*one body*”

I Corinthians 12:12: “...the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ”

I Corinthians 12:13: “For by one Spirit are we all baptized into *one body*, whether we be Jews or Gentiles”

I Corinthians 12:18: “Now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased Him”

I Corinthians 12:27: “Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular”

Ephesians 4:4: “There is *one body*...”

Acts 26:17: “...the Gentiles, unto whom *now* I send thee”

Acts 11:18: “Then hath God also *to the Gentiles* granted repentance unto life”

Acts 14:27: “God...*had opened* the door of faith *to the Gentiles*”

Luke 13:6: “A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none”

Luke 13:7: “Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none; *cut it down*; why cumbereth it the ground?”

Luke 13:8,9: “And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: And if it bear fruit, well: and if not, *then after that* thou shalt cut it down”

I Thessalonians 2:16: “...the wrath *is come upon them* to the uttermost”

Romans 11:12: “...the fall of them...”

Romans 11:12: “...the *diminishing* of them...”

Acts 13:46: “It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, *we turn to the Gentiles*”

Acts 18:6: “And when they opposed themselves, and blasphemed, he...said unto them, Your blood be upon your own heads; I am clean; *from henceforth I will go unto the Gentiles*”

II Chronicles 36:5,6: “Jehoikim...began to reign...Against him came up Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and bound him...Nebuchadnezzar also *carried of the vessels of the house of the Lord* to Babylon, and put them in his temple at Babylon”

II Chronicles 36:9,10: “Jehoichin...began to reign...And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar...brought him to Babylon, *with the goodly vessels of the house of the Lord*”

II Chronicles 36:18: “And *all* the vessels of the house of God...*all* these he brought to Babylon. And they burnt the house of God...”

Romans 11:25: “I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant *of this mystery*...that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles be come in”

Romans 16:25: “...my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ *according to the revelation of the mystery*”

Isaiah 60:1-3: “...the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee...and the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to *the brightness of thy rising*”

Romans 11:11: “...through their *fall* salvation is come unto the Gentiles”

Proverbs 17:15: “He that justifieth the wicked, and he that condemneth the just, even they both are abomination to the Lord”
