INSTRUCTIONS and THOUGHTS

Some of Pastor O’Hair’s works are hard to find. The front cover of his booklet is typically reproduced in the summary of the work and in the first page of each work. This may help the reader in identifying each specific booklet.

In his listing of booklets he sometime used partial titles or even synonyms of the true title, therefore a definitive list is almost impossible to construct.

Since many of the titles are esoteric and do not intuitively suggest the content of the work, therefore, a summary of each of the works have been prepared by the copyist.

Included in some of Pastor O’Hair’s publications were the works of other Grace pastors and teachers. These have also been reproduced.

When you select one of the formats below, by clicking on it, you will be taken to the index of the summaries relative to that format.

In the Microsoft Word format, go to the table of contents in the index of the summaries. Select the title and click on its page number. This will take you to the summary of the work. Clicking on the icon at the summary will take you to the work. Microsoft Word is needed on your computer to access all of the features.

In the Adobe Acrobat formats, select the summary of the work in the Bookmarks. Clicking on the title in the summary will take you to the work. If you lose navigation, close all windows, go to Start, Run, type in START.pdf, Enter.

When you open a work as an E-Book it will open in Full Screen so that you may read the work as you would a book in hand. Use the Esc key if you want to use the Bookmarks or other tools. Use the ‘Return To Index’ button to exit the work.

The web addresses for H. A. Ironside’s: “Wrongly Dividing the Word of Truth” and “Baptism, What Saith the Scriptures” are given in lieu of copying them. A. E. Bishops’ “Tongues, Signs, and Visions” was copied.

In order to be able to search the writings for specific verses all Scripture references have been changed to the following format: Roman Number, Full Name, Chapter, Colon, Verse. For example: II Corinthians 12:12.

The Bible was Pastor O’Hair’s vorpal sword, with which he destroyed the teachings of those who would not rightly divide the scriptures. The greatest joys I received from making this CD were the hours I spent reformatting his writings. I could almost hear his voice, as he wrote much as he preached.

When a student from The Milwaukee Bible Institute would visit Pastor O'Hair in his church they would be offered an opportunity to go into the storeroom and take as many booklets as they could use.

I remember an incident concerning a couple with whom I had shared the Message of Grace. They became listeners of his weekly broadcast in the Chicago area. They wrote to Pastor O'Hair and asked for a list of his writings, telling him how much they loved the grace message. They never received the list, instead, a week later they received a box with a collections of his works.

It is in this spirit that I am making his works available without charge.

This is the group who broadcast every Tuesday evening at 9:30 to 10 over radio station WSBC, 1230 kilocycles.

We understand that our Tuesday WSBC broadcast is the only evening gospel broadcast in this section (except Sundays). Just think of the worldly programs and so little time given to the Lord's message.

At one time North Shore Church and Pastor O'Hair owned and operated their own radio station. It's call letters were WPCC (We Preach Christ Crucified). Chas. F. Baker was the chief engineer.

Pastor O'Hair was heard on WMBI (Moody Bible Institute station) for a short period of time.

NORTH SHORE CHURCH

North Shore Church is located in “uptown” Chicago, Sheridan Road and Wilson Avenue. This organization was formerly “the North Shore Congregational Church”. The building was constructed in 1906.

There has been only three pastors, namely, James Ainslie, Paul Riley Allen and John C. O’Hair. Mr. O’Hair’s pastorate dates from August, 1923.

North Shore Church is undenominational but in it’s membership are former Methodists, Mennonites, Episcopalians, Swedish Covenant, Lutherans, Presbyterians, Baptists, Plymouth Brethren, Quakers, Congregationalists, Roman Catholics and Jews. But now we are just sinners saved by grace.

Today, November 2003, the church building is occupied by the Uptown Baptist Church.
