

Ezra 1:1 Cross References

Jer. 29:10: “Thus saith the Lord...after seventy years be accomplished at Babylon I will visit you, and perform My good word toward you, *in causing you to return to this place*”

Proverbs 21:1: “*The king’s heart is in the hand of the Lord, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever He will*”

Isaiah 45:1-4: “Thus saith the Lord...*to Cyrus*...For Jacob My servant’s sake, and Israel ...I have even called thee *by thy name*: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known Me”

Is.45:13: “I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, *and he shall let go My captives*

Isaiah 45:13: “and he shall let go my captives, *not for price nor reward*, saith the Lord”

Isaiah 45:2: “*I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight*: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron”

Isaiah 44:24,28: “Thus saith the Lord...of Cyrus, He is My shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure: even saying to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be built; *and to the temple, Thy foundation shall be laid*”

Acts 7:45,46: “David...desired to find a tabernacle for the God of Jacob. *But Solomon built Him an house*”

Genesis 12:3: “...*I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee...*”

Luke 7:3-5: “When he heard of Jesus, he sent unto him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal his servant. And when they came to Jesus, they besought Him instantly, saying, That he was worthy for whom He should do this: *For he loveth our nation, and he hath built us a synagogue*”

Deut. 32:31: “Their rock is not as our Rock, *even our enemies themselves being judges*”

I Samuel 4:8: “Woe unto us! who shall deliver us out of the hand of these mighty Gods? *these be the Gods that smote the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness*”

Romans 7:23: “I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and *bringing me into captivity* to the law of sin which is in my members”

II Timothy 2:26: “...recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, *who are taken captive by him at his will*”

Ezra 7:15: “...the silver and gold, *which the king and his counselors have freely offered* unto the God of Israel...”

Exodus 3:22; 11:2: “every woman shall borrow of her neighbour...jewels of silver, and jewels of gold...let every man borrow of his neighbour...jewels of silver, and...gold”

Exodus 12:36: “...and the Lord gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them such things as they required. *And they spoiled the Egyptians*”

Isaiah 60:9,10: “...the isles...bring...their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the Lord...*and the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls...*”

II Chronicles 23:12: “*And when he was in affliction, he besought the Lord his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers*”

Psalms 119:67,71: “*Before I was afflicted I went astray: but now have I kept Thy Word...It is good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn Thy statutes*”

Philippians 4:11: “I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, *therewith to be content*”

Ephesians 2:21: “...an holy temple *in the Lord*...an habitation of God through the Spirit”

Jeremiah 27:21: “thus saith the Lord of hosts...concerning the vessels that remain in the house of the Lord...they shall be carried to Babylon, and there shall they be *until the day that I visit them, saith the Lord; then will I bring them up, and restore them to this place*”

Ezra 5:14: “...the vessels also of gold and silver of the house of God...Cyrus...delivered unto one, whose name was Sheshbazzar, *whom he had made governor*”

Haggai 1:1: “Zerubbabel...*governor of Judah...*”

Deuteronomy 28:1,13: “...if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all His commandments...*the Lord shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath...*”

Deuteronomy 28:43,44: “But...if thou wilt *not* hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God...*the stranger that is within thee shall get up above thee very high; and thou shalt come down very low...he shall be the head, and thou shalt be the tail*”

Daniel 2:37,38: “Thou, O king, art *a king of kings*...God...hath given *thee* a kingdom...and wheresoever the children of men dwell...hath He given into thine hand, and hath made thee *ruler over them all*. Thou art this *head of gold*”

Luke 21:24: “Jerusalem shall be trodden down...until *the times of the Gentiles* be fulfilled

Luke 21:25-27: “...then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power...”

Revelation 5:6,10: “...a Lamb...hast made us unto our God *kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth*”
