

Ezra 8:15 *Cross References*

Hosea 6:2: “After two days will He revive us: *in the third day He will raise us up*, and we shall live in His sight”

Ezra 7:15,16: ...to carry *the silver and gold*, which the king and his counselors have freely offered unto the God of Israel...*and all the silver and gold* that thou canst find in all the province of Babylon, *with the freewill offering of the people...*”

I Chronicles 12:32: “...the children of Issachar, which were men that had *understanding of the times*, to know what Israel ought to do...”

Psalm 84:10: “I had rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness”

Psalm 69:10: “...I wept, *and chastened my soul with fasting...*”

II Samuel 12:23: “But now he is dead, *wherefore should I fast?...*”

Joel 2:12-15: “...turn...with all your heart, *and with fasting*, and with weeping...turn unto the Lord your God...*who knoweth if He will return and repent...*”

Jonah 3:5-10: “The people of Nineveh...proclaimed a fast...saying...*Who can tell if God will turn and repent*, and turn away from His fierce anger, that we perish not? *And God saw their works...*and...repented of the evil that He had said that He would do unto them

I Corinthians 7:4,5: “The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband...likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body...Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, *that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer...*”

Psalm 33:18,19: “Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear Him...*to deliver their soul from death...*”

Galatians 4:1-7: “...the heir, as long as he is a *child*, differeth nothing from a *servant...*thou art no more a servant, *but a son....*”

Acts 15:38: “But Paul *thought not good* to take him with them, who departed from them from Pamphylia, and went not with them to the work”

Colossians 2:8: “Beware lest any man *spoil you* through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ”

Ephesians 1:7: “...the riches of His grace...” (cf. Ephesians 2:7)

Acts 20:30: “Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them”

II Timothy 2:2: “the things that thou hast heard of me...*the same commit thou to faithful men*, who shall be able to teach others also”

Romans 1:1: “Paul...an apostle...separated *unto* the gospel of God”

Numbers 3:9: “...the Levites...are *wholly* given *unto* Him...”

I Timothy 4:15: “Meditate upon these things; *give thyself wholly to them...*”

I Timothy 6:13,14: “Keep this commandment...*until the appearing of our Lord Jesus...*”

II Corinthians 6:14-17: “Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers...wherefore come out from among them, *and be ye separate*, saith the Lord...”

Leviticus 18:26-28: “Ye shall therefore...not commit any of these abominations...(for all these abominations have the men of the land done, which were before you)..That the land spue not you out also, when ye defile it, as it spued out the nations that were before you”

Ephesians 5:6: “...because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. *Be not ye therefore partakers with them...*”

I Kings 11:7: “Ashtoreth...goddess of the Zidonians, and...Milcom...*abomination of the Ammonites*”

Deuteronomy 27:15: “Cursed be the man that maketh any graven or molten image, *an abomination unto the Lord...*”

Deuteronomy 7:1-4: “When the Lord...shall bring thee into the land...and hath cast out many nations before thee...thou shalt make no covenant with them...neither shalt thou make marriages with them...nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son. *For they will turn away thy son from following Me*, that they may serve other gods...”

Nehemiah 13:25,26: “...ye shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons..Did not Solomon..sin by these things? yet among many nations was there no king like him...nevertheless *even him* did outlandish women cause to sin”

Nehemiah 13:23-25: “In those days also saw I Jews that had married wives of Ashdod, of Ammon, and of Moab...And I contended with them, and cursed them, *and smote certain of them*, and plucked off *their* hair...”

Psalms 119:136: “Rivers of waters run down mine eyes, *because they keep not thy law*”

Deuteronomy 7:3,4: “Neither shalt thou make marriages with them...*so will the anger of the Lord be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly*”

Philippians 2:12: “...work out your own salvation *with fear and trembling*”
